

**NOTICE FOR CANDIDATES
HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 28
(Ponderosa VFD Area)**

To all Interested Persons:

Notice is hereby given that there are three positions on the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 28 scheduled for election on May 12, 2012.

HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 28 ("ESD 28") is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, operating under Chapter 775 of the Texas Health & Safety Code ("H&S Code"), and provides fire suppression and rescue services.

The ESD 28 Board is a five member board. The board members serve staggered four year terms. This election three seats are up for election.

As provided in Chapter 775, H&S Code, to be eligible for election to the ESD 28 Board, a person must be at least 18 years of age and reside within the boundaries of the District. (However, please see Section 141.001, Texas Election Code and Section 775.0355, H&S Code, for additional eligibility requirements.) A person interested in being a candidate must give a sworn application of intention to run for the Board. The general form of the application is set forth in Section 141.031, Texas Election Code and may be obtained from the Texas Secretary of State website (<http://www.sos.state.tx.us/elections/voter/2012dates.shtml>). Prepared forms may also be obtained from the District Secretary, James Chatterton, Ponderosa VFD, located at 17061 Rolling Creek, Houston, Texas 77090, or from Howard L. Katz, District Counsel, Two Memorial City Plaza, 820 Gessner, Suite 1710, Houston, Texas 77024. The completed application must be received by the District Secretary, James Chatterton, Ponderosa VFD, located at 17061 Rolling Creek, Houston, Texas 77090 by 5:00 P.M., March 5, 2012. The procedures and time requirements for a write-in candidate for Commissioner are governed by Subchapter C, Chapter 146, Election Code.

All applicants are referred to the Texas Ethics Commission filing requirements under Title 15, Texas Election Code.
