

OUT OF DISTRICT MEMBERS

A. Purpose:

To allow existing members to remain active members after they have relocated their principal living address out of district and to clarify rules on candidates for membership who live outside of district.

B. Effective December 1, 2003 for members who move after this date

C. Current Members:

1. Members in good standing who have moved outside the PFD boundaries **may maintain active membership by meeting or exceeding training and other attendance requirements.**
2. In addition, these individuals must participate in station staffing program each calendar month. The member will have a choice of recording a minimum of 24 hours of station staffing over the course of the calendar month in 4-hour minimum blocks during the day or to participate in two 12 hour overnight blocks during calendar month.
3. The member should record his/her hours in the Station staffing log binder in the dormitory area for PVIP considerations (when staying in the dormitory) and must record all staffing hours in the station-staffing log. The above requirement does not include paid staffing times.
4. The staffing program coordinator is responsible for verifying compliance and reporting each month at the officers meetings. The Command Staff may accept or deny individual members for this program. If a member does not maintain the requirements of this program, the member will be given one 30 day warning. If the member does not meet the requirements a second time, the member must resign immediately.

D. Candidates for Membership:

1. Candidate must reside in PVFD district or in an approved proximity of PFD district.
 - a. Any area that is immediately adjacent to PFD boundaries is acceptable for members' residency.
 - b. Areas that are not immediately adjacent require judgment on the part of the Command Staff to allow for membership within the PFD organization. Long-term members who move out of district must have Command Staff approval to maintain membership.
